1. Beginning October 1, 2024, new CJIS requirements will apply to all law enforcement agencies and organizations handling Criminal Justice Information (CJI).
2. You will need to maintain visitor logs for at least one year, review them quarterly, and report anomalies immediately.
3. Access to visitor records should be limited to authorized personnel, with minimal Personally Identifiable Information (PII) collected.
